Current financing is 0-percent for 60 months or a \$3,000.00 dollars rebate. 2.9 financing for 72 months, no rebate, on all new corvette orders or in stock inventory. Also \$1,000.00 dollars loyal customer bonus is also available to us on 1999 or newer Corvettes purchases. All new corvettes come with a 48-month 50,000 mile warranty and 100,000 mile on the power train. On

March 8th Grey Chevrolet is ordering a 2012 Carlisle Blue Metallic Grand Sport, which will be arriving around June 2012. Currently Grey Chevrolet has 2011 Torch Red Convertible for around \$52,000.00 dollars. GM is mandating that every Chevrolet dealer that is authorized to sell Corvetts must sell (4) 2013-C-6s in order to be eligible to sell the new 2014-C-7s.

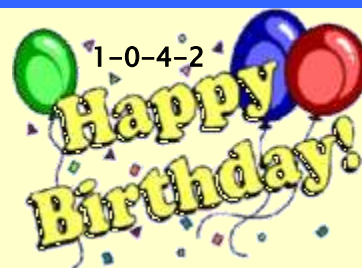

As most of you know when we vote for our new Executive Board we are asked to recommend 2 charities for GOCC to sponsor each year. I would ask you to consider the following:

I would like to recommend we continue to support the Kitsap Humane Society as one of our local charities. We usually have a quilt raffle with a Corvette theme to raise the \$500.00 we donate once a year in springtime. I am willing to make and donate the cost of this quilt for this venture. The Humane Society does a lot of work to find good homes for 95% of their animal clients. They also offer free or subsidized spay and neuter surgery for folks on limited incomes. They do surgeries on animals that need it to get back to good health for adoption. They also do a lot of community outreach. They have always been grateful for our sponsorship. At the end of summer, or thereabouts, we collect food, toys, bedding, and other items from members. I hope you will consider voting the Kitsap Humane Society as one of our charities.

The other charity I would like to recommend we sponsor is the Kitsap Sun Bellringer Fund which is collected in the month of December for use in the counties food banks. This last year they collected over \$100,000. All the money goes directly into the food banks for local families. (This is different from the Salvation Army bell ringers which is a different enterprise altogether.) I would like to see GOCC raise another \$500.00 this year through raffles and donations to the club to fund this charity.
