Callaway Introduces 25th Anniversary Limited Edition Callaway Corvette

To commemorate the 25th anniversary of the Callaway Corvette, Callaway Cars collaborated with Chevrolet to arrange a production run of 25 uniquely prepared 2012 Corvette Grand Sports coupes and convertibles.

The 25th Anniversary Limited Edition Callaway Corvette will be unveiled at Callaway’s “Dealer Summit” national sales meeting at the National Corvette Museum, Bowling Green KY, on April 23. The 25 RPO B2K cars are scheduled to be built at the GM Bowling Green Assembly Plant in April and will be shipped to Callaway Cars’ facilities for final assembly to “25th Anniversary” model specifications, including Callaway supercharger

system, exhaust system, suspension components, carbon fiber body aerodynamics, and Callaway wheels and tires. The completed cars will be delivered to Authorized Callaway/Chevrolet Dealers where new owners will take delivery. Buyers may also choose to take delivery at the National Corvette Museum or at the constructing Callaway facility.

In conjunction with this milestone anniversary, the National Corvette Museum is hosting a 14-car "Callaway" exhibit April 23-July 27.
