2015 Corvette Stingray Convertible

When the C7 Corvette debuted in 2014, it was a significant improvement from the C6 Corvette. The 2015 model incorporated more advanced technology, so the owner traded their 2010 Corvette Grand Sport convertible and ordered this Corvette from the factory in November of 2014. Options included the ZLT package, ZF1 appearance package, chrome aluminum wheels, performance data and video recorder with navigation, 8 Speed paddle shift automatic transmission, and multi-mode performance exhaust. This Stingray wears a vibrant paint scheme of Crystal Red Tintcoat.

1995 Corvette Convertible

Highlighting the design cues of the 1960s, the C4 generation battled restrictive fuel emissions issues as well as some performance issues. This resulted in an underappreciated generation of the Corvette. However, if one looks at the minimalist styling with this dynamic color, the C4 truly shines!

One of only 909 Bright Aqua Metallic Corvettes built in 1995, this Corvette represents 11 years of continuous improvement for the C4 Corvette. C4s were now standard with a big brake package including an enhanced ABS system, and a new fuel system in 1995 compatible with alcohol-blend fuels. Combining this with subtle changes in interior refinements and exterior style enhancements, this would be the last of the major styling developments of the C4 prior to the introduction of the C5 Corvette in 1997. This glimmering gem is a multiple show award winner.

It was too windy and continually put her carefully coiffed hair style into disarray. Thus, the owner traded it in for coupes and hard tops and they have been happily married ever since!
