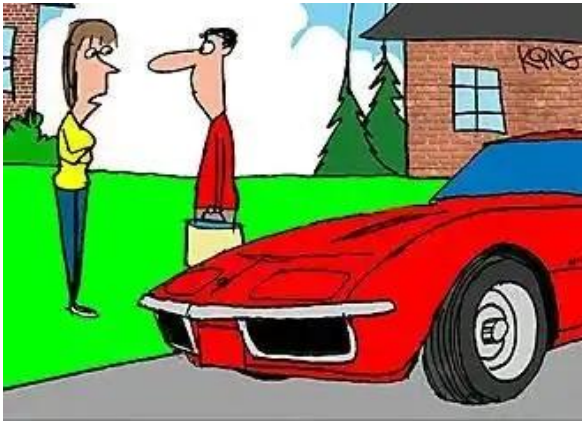


## Message from the President

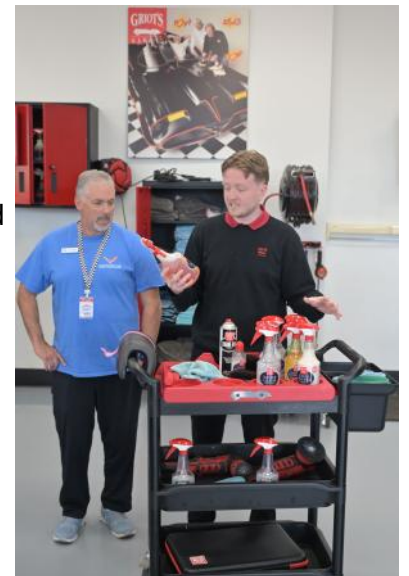

After the festivities, the Griot's Garage staff ushered everyone into the Car Care School and demonstrated products for detailing engine bays, interiors, and glass.

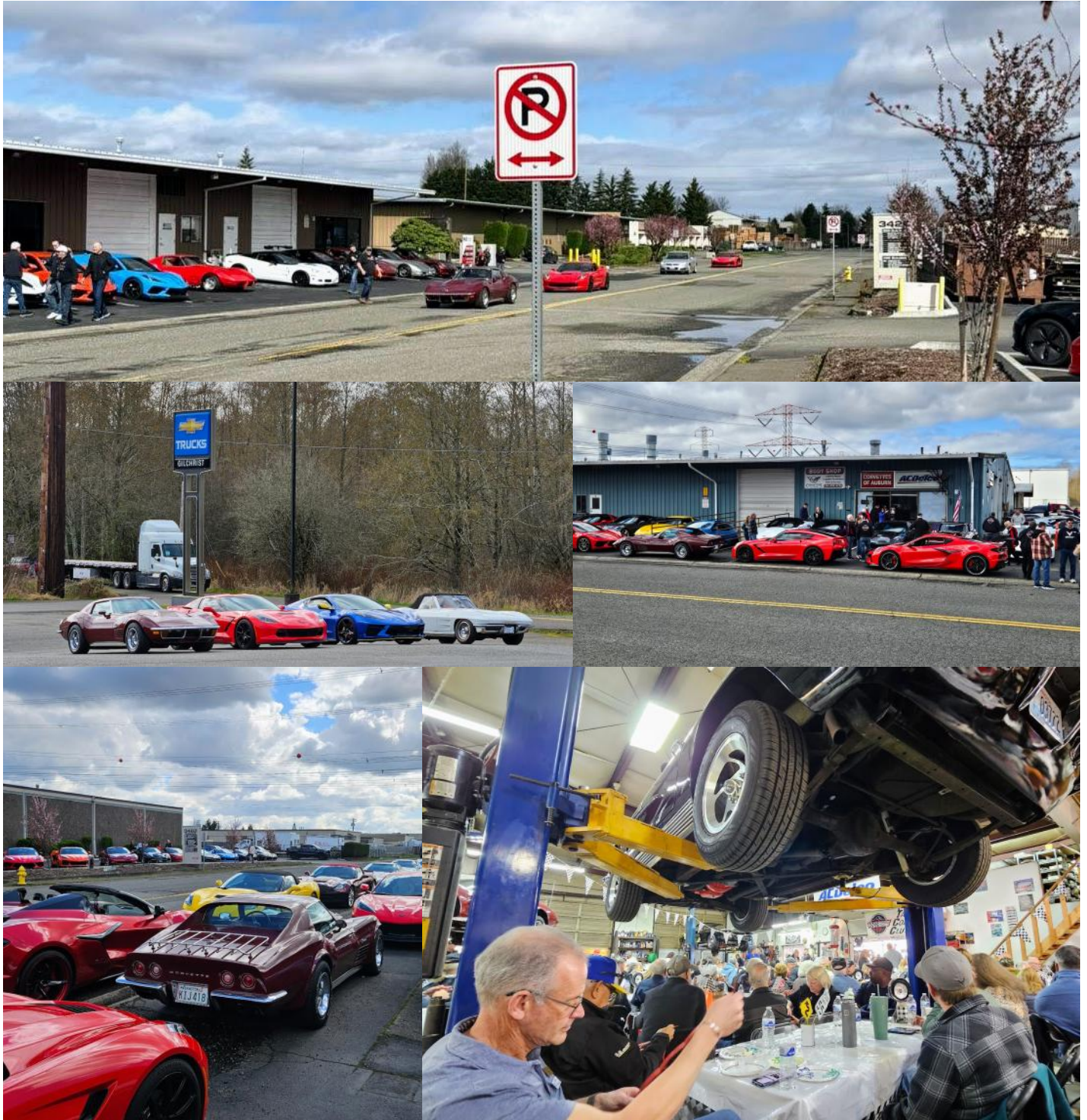


## TCC Open House
